Re: Formal Request of Notice for Addison County Proposed Regional Plans and Amendments

Dear Mr. Lougee:

I am writing on behalf of Vermont Natural Resources Council (“VNRC”) to request notice of Addison County Regional Planning Commission’s submissions of proposed regional plans and amendments to the Land Use Review Board. Under 24 V.S.A. § 4348(d)(1), this request entitles VNRC to notice by the Addison County Regional Planning Commission at least 30 days prior to the first hearing on the proposed plan or amendment. As § 4348(d)(1) states, the notice provided to VNRC must include:

- A copy of the proposed plan or amendment;
- A report documenting conformance with the goals established in section 4302 of this chapter and the plan elements established in section 4348a of this chapter; and
- A description of any changes to the Regional Future Land Use Map with a request for general comments and for specific comments with respect to the extent to which the plan or amendment is consistent with the goals established in 24 V.S.A. § 4302.

VNRC appreciates the extensive work of the Addison County Regional Planning Commission and looks forward to reviewing the proposed plans, amendments, and their accompanying documents.
