Subject: Killington's Growth Center designation
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Dear Members of the Land Use Review Board,

I am writing to you regarding the application of Killington Resort and Great Gulf Killington to have you grant Tier 1A status for the Killington Six Peaks Village project. My husband and I have been homeowners on Pico Mountain in Killington for 29 years. We both hope that you will approve this application. We believe that this designation will be incredibly beneficial for the town and the region.

It is our understanding that this designation holds the resort and developers to the same environmental, traffic, and natural-resources requirements as any other project, but would allow put the Town and the regional planning commission in charge of oversight and approvals. This should make for an efficient process and facilitate the project progressing on an optimal timeline. This project has been a priority for the state for decades, and it is clear that this project has the support of the Town, residents, the Resort, and the developer (Great Gulf). It therefore seems to us that this project is exactly the type of project that Tier 1A status was designed for.
